**CULLAUN ANNUAL REGATTA &

1.0 Rules

1.1 The event will be governed by ISAF Racing Rules of Sailing and the prescriptions of the ISA, this Notice of Race and any amendments thereto, except as any of these are changed by the Sailing Instructions [SIs].

2.0 Eligibility

2.1 Competitors are reminded that no individual or body involved in the organisation of this event accepts any liability for injury or damage. Each helm must sign a declaration that his/her boat is covered by a policy of Third Party Indemnity Insurance of not less than €3,000,000. Entries are accepted on the basis that in no circumstances will any liability for injury to person(s) or property attach to Cullaun Sailing Club (CSC). All competitors will be automatically members of the CSC for the duration of the event and will be subject to the rules of the club.

2.2 Entry fee will be €30 per boat for all Mirror Dinghy entries. Junior prices apply for entries to all participating in Cullaun Regatta only. Registration can be completed online prior to the event here:

Competitors under 18 must have parents or guardians signature on entry form.

3.0 Notices to Competitors

3.1 Notices to competitors will be posted on the official notice board of the CSC.

3.2 Helms with a class ranking may not change crews during an Event. Exceptions may be made on medical or compassionate grounds to the event committee.

3.3 Equipment (i.e. foils, spars, and sails) shall not be changed between races except in the case of damage and then only with the approval of the Race Officer.

4.0 Sailing instructions

4.1 Sailing Instructions will be posted on: www.cullaunsailingclub.com one week prior to the event and will be available on the morning of the event.

4.2 Any change to the sailing instructions will be posted before 10.00 on the day it will take effect. Any change to the schedule of races will be posted by 18.00 on the day before it will take effect. It is the sole responsibility of each competitor to ensure that they have apprised themselves of any such alterations.

5.0 Schedule of Racing

5.1 Briefing – A briefing will be held at 11.00am on Saturday August 30th

5.2 Racing.

Six races are scheduled.

Saturday 30/08/25 – Up to 4 Races

Sunday. 31/08/25 – Up to 4 races

Warning Signal First Race **12.00am Saturday**

Warning Signal First Race **11.00 am Sunday**

5.3 An alternative programme may be run if weather conditions or adequate boat numbers do not favour the above programme, this will be at the discretion of the Event committee (Class and Club representatives and the Race Officer). Any changes to this programme will be signalled at the briefing.

6.0 Scoring System

Two races are required to be completed to constitute a series.

When fewer than five races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of their race scores. This changes RRS A2.1.

When four races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of their race scores excluding their worst score.

7.0 PRIZES

Prizes will be given as follows:

Overall 1st, 2nd 3rd. Youth 1st, 2nd 3rd. (These may be subject to change)

Association Trophies shall be held by the winners and returned by them (in good time and in good order) to the Organisers of the event in the following year. The winners shall be responsible for engraving the trophies.

8. INSURANCE

Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third party liability insurance with a minimum of €3,000,000 or the equivalent.

9. CATERING

- Competitors are responsible for providing their own food and drink.
A BBQ (weather permitting) has been arranged for after sailing on Saturday.
- Tea/Coffee and snacks will be available onshore throughout Saturday and Sunday.
- Drinking water will be available at the clubhouse.

10. CAMPING /ACCOMMODATION

- Camping is available on a members farm close by. Camper Vans can stay in the area beside the compound and can avail of the clubhouse facilities during their stay. Cullaun SC does not have any shower facilities in the changing rooms.
